Moses: A Baby in a Basket



Step Three: Do the activity and the craft.

Craft: Hiding Baby Moses

Before the lesson begins, print out the numbered Baby Moses [on pages 7 and 8](#). Print and hide one per child in your class throughout your room. Hide a few extra if you're not sure how many kids you will have.

Tell your kids, "To keep Moses safe, his mother hid him in a basket. In our classroom, I have hidden one Baby Moses for each of you." Then, give a [number card](#) to each child. (Katie, you will be searching for Moses #2, etc.) Kids will then scour the room for each hidden Baby Moses. They can only keep the baby if it matches their number card. If it does not match, they must re-hide it and keep looking.

Craft: Baby Moses in a Basket

Before the lesson begins, print a craft template (basket, baby, reeds, and Bible verse) for each child. Gather scissors, glue, and coloring supplies.

Give each child a set of craft templates and ask them to color all the pieces and cut them out. Then, fold the basket in half, place Baby Moses inside, and glue it together. Finally, glue on the reeds and the Bible verse wherever you'd like.



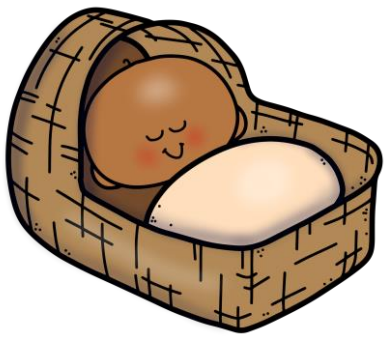
Step Four: Finish with the take-home worksheet.

The 'Moses: A Baby in a Basket' coloring page is the perfect way to wrap up the lesson and create a take-home page that includes caregivers in what you have learned. Kids will color a picture, write down their memory verse, and add the key takeaway (a "big idea") from the story.

Memory verse suggestion from the story:

She named him Moses, saying, "I drew him out of the water." Exodus 2:10b NIV

Big idea suggestion: God protected Moses.
